



## **Myuge Cabernet 2006**

Without question the best wine we have ever made at Myuge. We were offered some really great opportunities this vintage and were lucky to be able to make a beautifully balanced, structurally tight, approachable wine that is, dare I say, a bit more of a serious wine than the 2005. This wine returns to its Rutherford roots, as well as a serious portion of fruit from the Howell Mountain. The middle palate of the wine is still from the parcels that made the 2005 so opulent, those parcels in Oakville and Yountville. A perfect blend of all of these parcels give the wine more structure, a better balance for the opulence that has been the hallmark of Myuge since its first vintage in 2002. Developed as a wine to be drunk by the glass, both immediately pleasing and able to work well with food, the 2006 has a more brooding serious note, maybe a little more mature in its style. The wine is a perfectly drinkable glass of wine, but it has this new dimension that I think will lend the wine to ageing. The 2006 Myuge is a wine I think will please those that have been fans of ours since the beginning but, like our little wine project, have gotten just a little bit older and a little more mature, and therefore are looking for something a little more serious in their everyday wines.
